Rules for pool users

- All swimmers must have company
- Children under 8 years of age must be actively supervised by someone who's at least 16, who can give
 immediate help
- Please make sure the gate is always securely closed upon leaving
- Nobody is to swim while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Check the depth of water before entering the pool
- Pushing or holding under the water is not permitted
- Food and drink is not permitted in the pool
- Check for hazards, such as steep slopes into deeper water
- No running around the pool
- Boogie boards, surf boards and kayaks are not to be used in the pool
- The first aid kit is stored in the female changing room
